It is not mandatory training, however it has been designed and developed to benefit all members of the workforce and assist them to upskill, and recognise and manage early signs of deteriorating health.

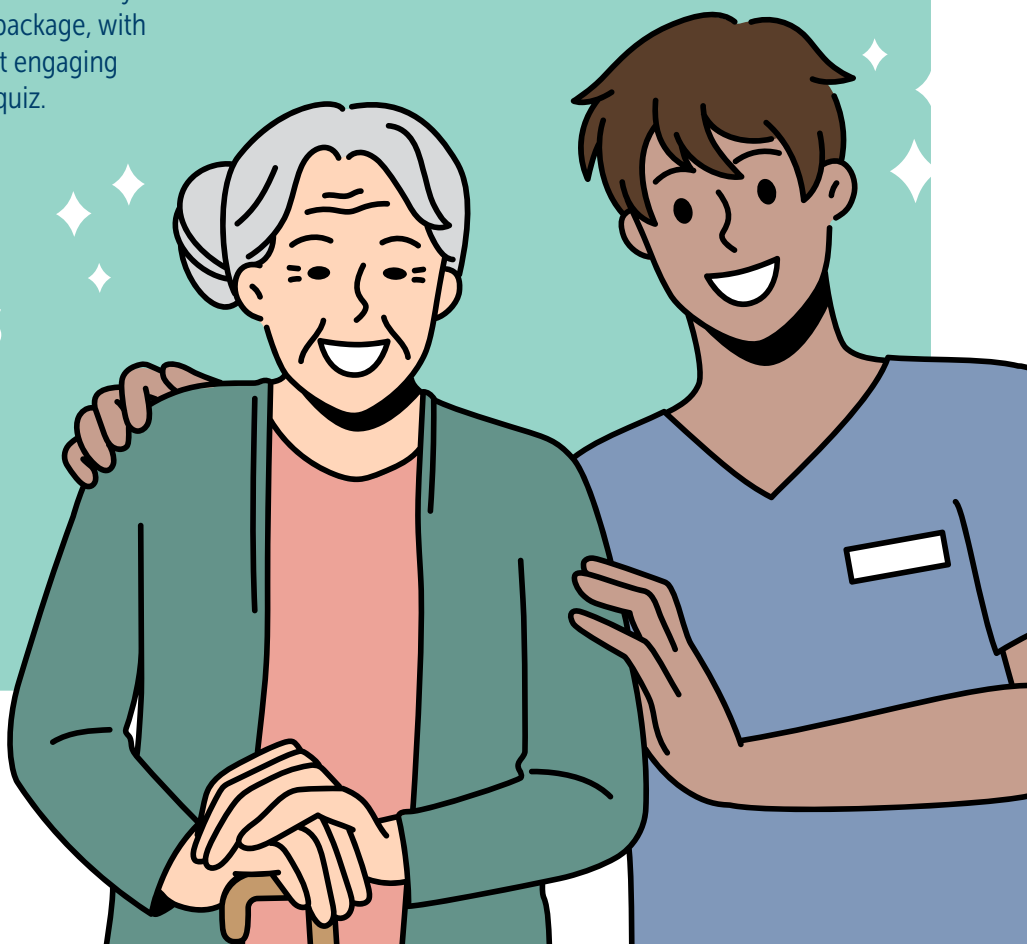
BERTIE is presented in an innovative and easy-to-digest 20-module self-paced package, with each module consisting of a short engaging video, summary sheet and short quiz.
