Goulburn Valley (GV) Health is a Regional Public Hospital and Health Service for the Hume Region of Victoria, with main campuses located at Shepparton, Tatura and Rushworth. The main campus in Shepparton is the major acute referral hospital for the sub region. Additional sites are also located in Shepparton, Seymour, Benalla and Wodonga. GV Health provides a range of acute, subacute, mental health, aged, primary health and community services across the Goulburn Sub-Region within the Hume Region.

ROLE STATEMENT:

The CAMHS Clinician will work in partnership with consumers, carers, families and other service providers to provide high quality mental health assessment, treatment and consultation services within a recovery oriented framework. GV CAMHS is responsible for providing tertiary level mental health care to children and young people under the age of 18 years.

The service has an ACT (Access Community Consultation and Brief Treatment) stream, responsible for intake, initial assessment, brief intervention and consultation services. The CARE steam (Comprehensive Assessment and Recovery) provides evidence based mental health intervention and case management to a defined caseload of young people experiencing high risk or complex mental health conditions.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES, ACTIVITIES AND DUTIES:

- Provision of advanced mental health care practice in biopsychosocial assessment, formulation and individualized recovery planning.
- Provision of risk assessments, safety planning and crisis management plans, through engagement with the consumer, family and carers, and health, education and welfare networks
- Provide evidence based therapeutic interventions to complex, high risk consumers, their families and network of service providers.
- Liaison and consultation with partner health, welfare and education providers.
- Maintain accurate, contemporaneous, timely file notes and other clinical documentation and complete appropriate and timely service statistics.
- Provide a high quality service to internal customers and consumers that reflects best practice and adds value to GV Health
- Assist the organisation in achieving clinical effectiveness by providing the appropriate systems, information or services to clinical areas

1. Provide quality and safe clinical care for consumers

- Ensure consumers, families/representatives or carers are provided with timely information and are involved in decision making about their care planning and treatment
- Accept accountability for own actions and seek guidance when a situation exceeds experience and/or knowledge
- Uphold and protect consumer rights, maintain strict confidentiality and continually practice to the principles of open disclosure
- Comply with best practice healthcare standards, legislation, and GV Health's Clinical Governance Framework and clinical practice guidelines
- Consumer feedback and complaints are responded to appropriately to ensure that issues are resolved and quality and safe clinical care is provided
- Maintain accurate and current clinical records ensuring documentation meets professional and legal standards
- Promptly report vital consumer observations that are outside the normal range as per clinical guidelines
- Ensure an effective discharge from hospital or services that reflects the needs of the consumer.





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2. Develop and maintain collaborative relationships with all disciplines

- Collaborate and communicate with all members of the health care team to achieve desired consumer outcomes
- Respect the decisions and actions of others
- Contribute to interdisciplinary team meetings and clinical education sessions to facilitate consumer care goals.

3. Support and participate in evidence-based programs to evaluate and improve the quality of consumer care and outcomes

- Maintain current knowledge of clinical practice
- Actively participate in identifying where improvements can be made to the quality of consumer care
- Participate in clinical audits, research, process redesign and accreditation against healthcare standards to ensure ongoing clinical practice improvement and the quality of consumer care.

4. Commit to ongoing professional development of self, other employees and the profession

- Maintain and demonstrate regulated clinical skills and competencies by undertaking professional development and completing mandatory training as defined by GV Health
- Undertake credentialing and review of scope of practice and work within these
- Improve performance by seeking feedback, setting goals and participating in annual performance reviews
- Support the development of others by acting as a resource to colleagues and participating in orientation and preceptoring of new employees and supervising students
- Provision of appropriate supervision to less experienced clinical employees
- Participate in committees and professional groups and disseminate relevant information to other health care professionals.

QUALITY, SAFETY, RISK and IMPROVEMENT

- Maintain an understanding of individual responsibility for consumer safety, quality and risk and adhere to the relevant policies, procedures and guidelines
- Maintain a safe working environment for yourself, your colleagues and members of the public
- Identify, report and manage risks and ensure actions are taken to prevent and minimise harm to consumers and the GV Health workforce
- Contribute to organisational quality and safety initiatives
- Minimise the risk of infection to consumers, residents, employees, visitors, contractors and the general public
- Comply with requirements of the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards and other relevant standards, regulations and legislative requirements.

- Where relevant collaborate with consumers and the community in the development, implementation and review of health service planning, policies and quality improvement activities
- Demonstrate sensitivity, empathy and respect for the customs, values and spiritual beliefs of others at all times
- Assist with the supervision of students where appropriate
- Understand and act in accordance with the GV Health Code of Conduct, values and relevant policies, procedures and guidelines
- Comply with the principles of Patient and Family Centred Care
- Promote GV Health as a quality regional health care provider





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KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS:

- Provision of care to a defined group of consumers
- Timely completion of documentation, outcome measures and submission of statistics
- Engagement in clinical supervision.
- Registration is maintained and working within scope of practice
- Attendance and active participation at meetings as required
- 100% compliance with core competencies and training requirements as outlined in the GV Health Education Framework
- Active participation in the Performance and Development review process

KEY SELECTION CRITERIA:

Mandatory

- Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency as a Registered Nurse,
 Occupational Therapist, Psychologist
- Registered Psychiatric Nurses must have: a post-graduate qualification or equivalent in mental health
- Psychologists must have: current psychology registration with the Psychology Board of Australia
- Occupational Therapists must be: eligible for registration with the Occupational Therapy Board of Australia
- Social Workers must be: eligible for membership of the Australian Association of Social Workers (AASW)
- Experience and expertise in the provision of assessment, treatment planning and intervention for people with a mental health disorder
- Experience in working collaboratively with healthcare, welfare and education agencies to support people in addressing mental health concerns
- Experience in the provision of mental health crisis assessments, risk assessments, safety planning and crisis management planning
- Sound skills in utilising basic computer applications.
- Satisfactory National History Criminal Check prior to commencement of employment
- Satisfactory Victorian 'Employee' Working with Children Check prior to commencement of employment
- Completion of a Commonwealth of Australia Statutory Declaration prior to commencement of employment.
- Evidence of full immunisation against Influenza

• Experience in working with children and adolescents in clinical mental health service provision
